Nomination Guidelines

Elite Women Around The World® dba Women's Business & Leadership Development Center is a global network of individuals, leaders, organizations, businesses, coming together with a shared mission to develop, grow and support the economic and social stability of women and girls through entrepreneurial and leadership programs.

EWAW platform for economic benefits: Leadership, mentorship, economic advancement & empowerment for women; Job creation and collaboration among women businesses; Educating and developing the next generation of women leaders; Building of alliances with businesses and civic organizations that encourage and embrace gender equality, diversity and inclusion; Advocating for programs that support the economic self-sufficiency, growth and wellness for all women with a key focus on underprivileged women and girls; Education and insights on business issues for global opportunities; Strategic networking among local, national and global leaders

A Woman Who:

- Has gone above and beyond in her call of duty
- Shown professional accomplishments
- Serves as a role model, assists and mentors other women and young girls
- Has created projects and programs for women in achieving entrepreneurship and leadership opportunities
- Is committed to society and the potential to contribute to shaping the future of the world

Eligibility

- Nominees may nominate themselves
- Nominating/Endorsing individual or organization must have direct experience of the nominee's work
- The award recipient must agree to accept the award in person at **Women's International Day, Sunday, March 8th, 2020, Cleveland, Ohio. Finalists and recipients will be notified by Monday, February 10th.**

Nominations must include the following items:

- Original signed nomination form
- Biographical information on the nominee up to 250 words
- One original and signed endorsement letter from organization or individual other than the nominator and if possible, additional supporting materials such as newspaper articles or publications.

Criteria (Maximum two pages plus Nomination Form)

The long-term impact of the award depends on the integrity nominee and nominators and the quality of their nominations. Descriptions should be specific as possible. Women will be chosen from all Sectors of society: Business (Finance, Engineering, IT, Science, Health, Medicine and Law.....) Education, Civil, Social Entrepreneurs, Politics and Government, Arts and Culture, Media, Entertainment, Fashion Industry.

- 1) Describe how the nominee has gone above and beyond in her call of duty.
- 2) List and describe the significant contributions and professional accomplishments made within or outside nominee's organization. List special recognitions, achievements and professional affiliations.
- 3) Describe how the nominee serves as a role model, assists and mentors other women and young girls.
- 4) Describe how the nominee has created projects and programs for women in achieving entrepreneurship and leadership opportunities.
- 5) Describe how the nominee is committed to society and the potential to contribute to shaping the future of the world.
